

Conditions for Placement in a Box Elder School District Dual Immersion Program

- 1. This application does not guarantee enrollment in the program. If the number of applications is greater than the number of available spaces in the program, the students will be selected at the District Level by a lottery.**
- 2. It is the responsibility of the parents to provide transportation to and from school for students in the dual immersion program, unless the child lives within the school boundaries and is deemed eligible to ride the bus.**
- 3. Immersion programs are most effective when students remain in the program for a sustained period of time. Students accepted into the program will be expected to continue with the program through 5th grade unless a team decision is made involving the parent, school staff and district specialists that it is the best interest of the student to have a different placement.**
- 4. Attendance is of key importance in academics as well as learning a second language. Students accepted into the dual immersion program will be expected to attend daily except in cases of illness or family emergency.**
- 5. It is not unusual for children to experience some fatigue and/or tears and frustration during the first months of a dual immersion program. If a child experiences prolonged frustration, a team meeting involving the parent will be held to determine the best course of action to remedy the situation.**
- 6. Parents need to read to/with their child at home 20-30 minutes daily in English.**
