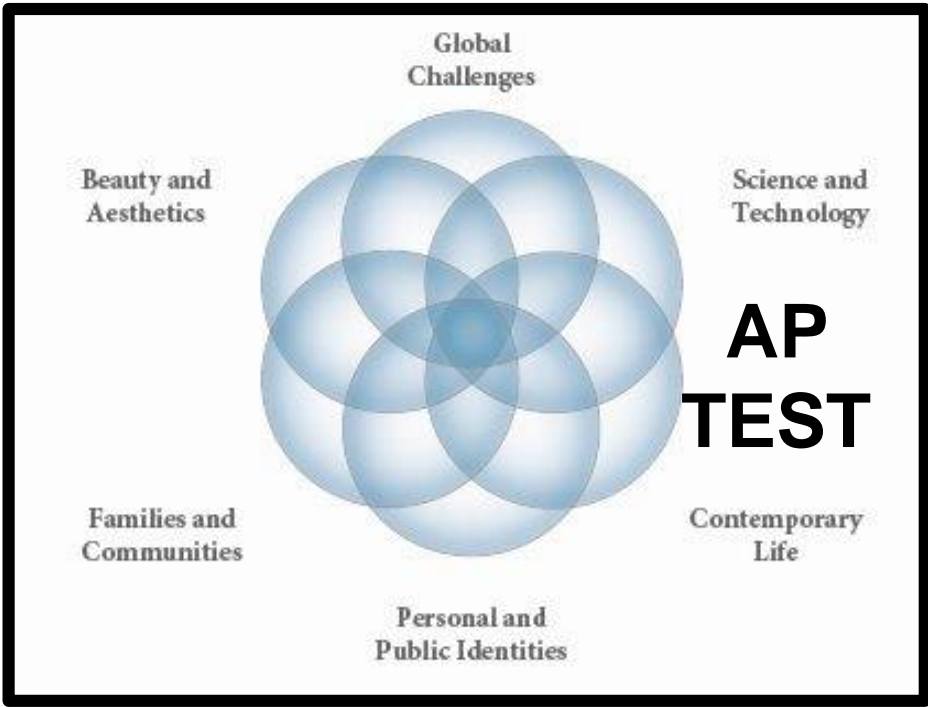

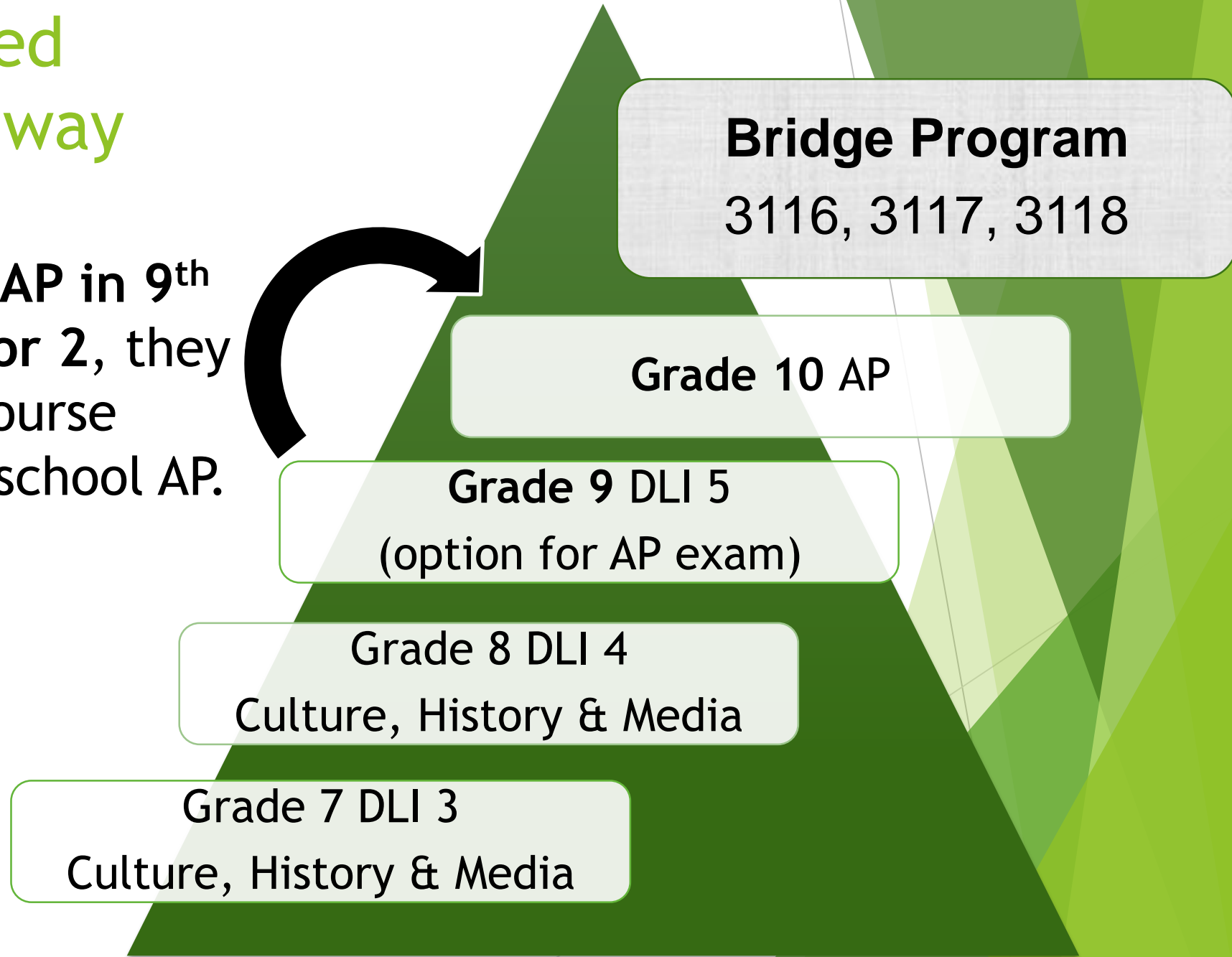

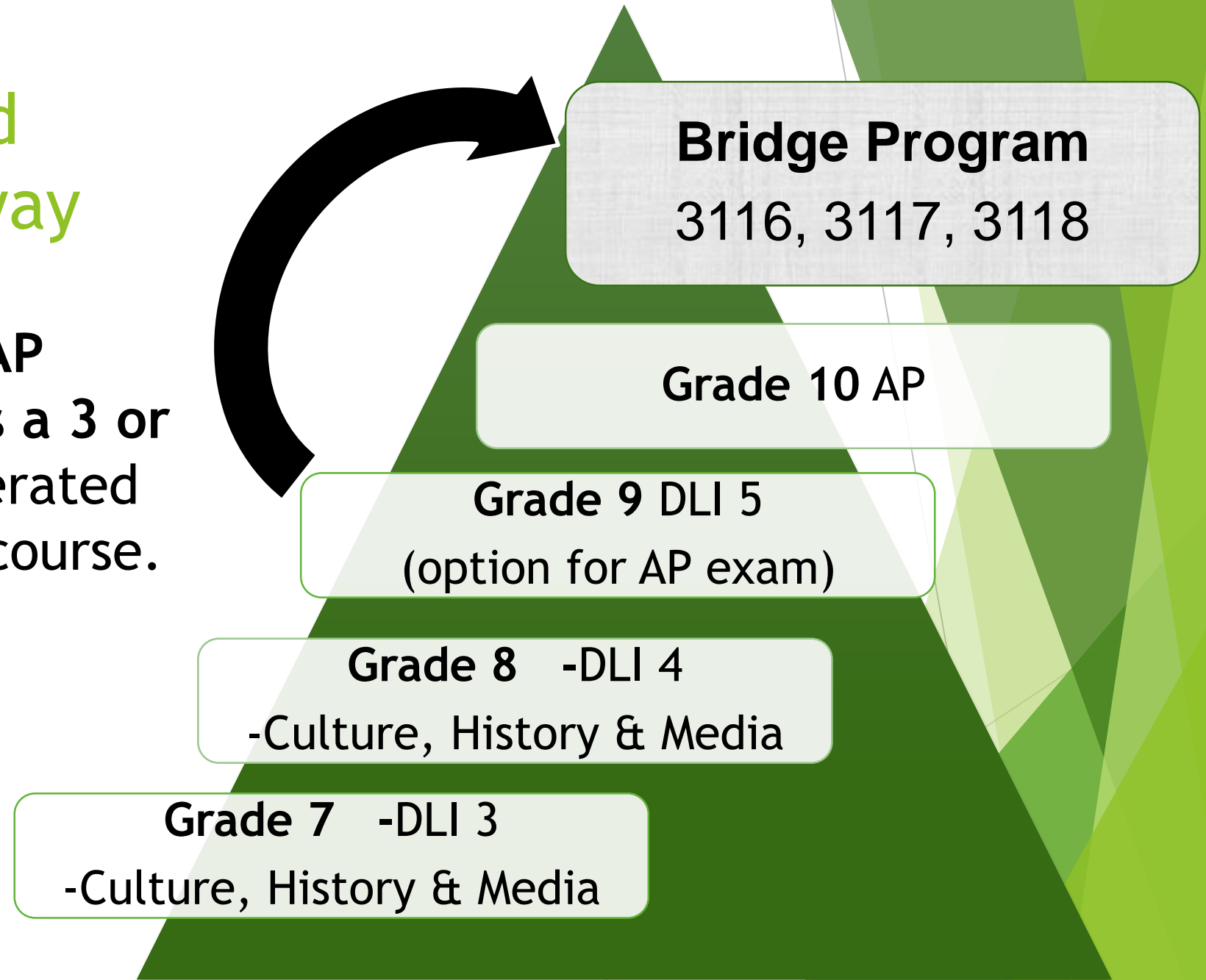
# Utah's Advanced Language Pathway

If a student attempts AP in 9<sup>th</sup> grade and scores a 1 or 2, they progress to the next course in the sequence: high school AP.



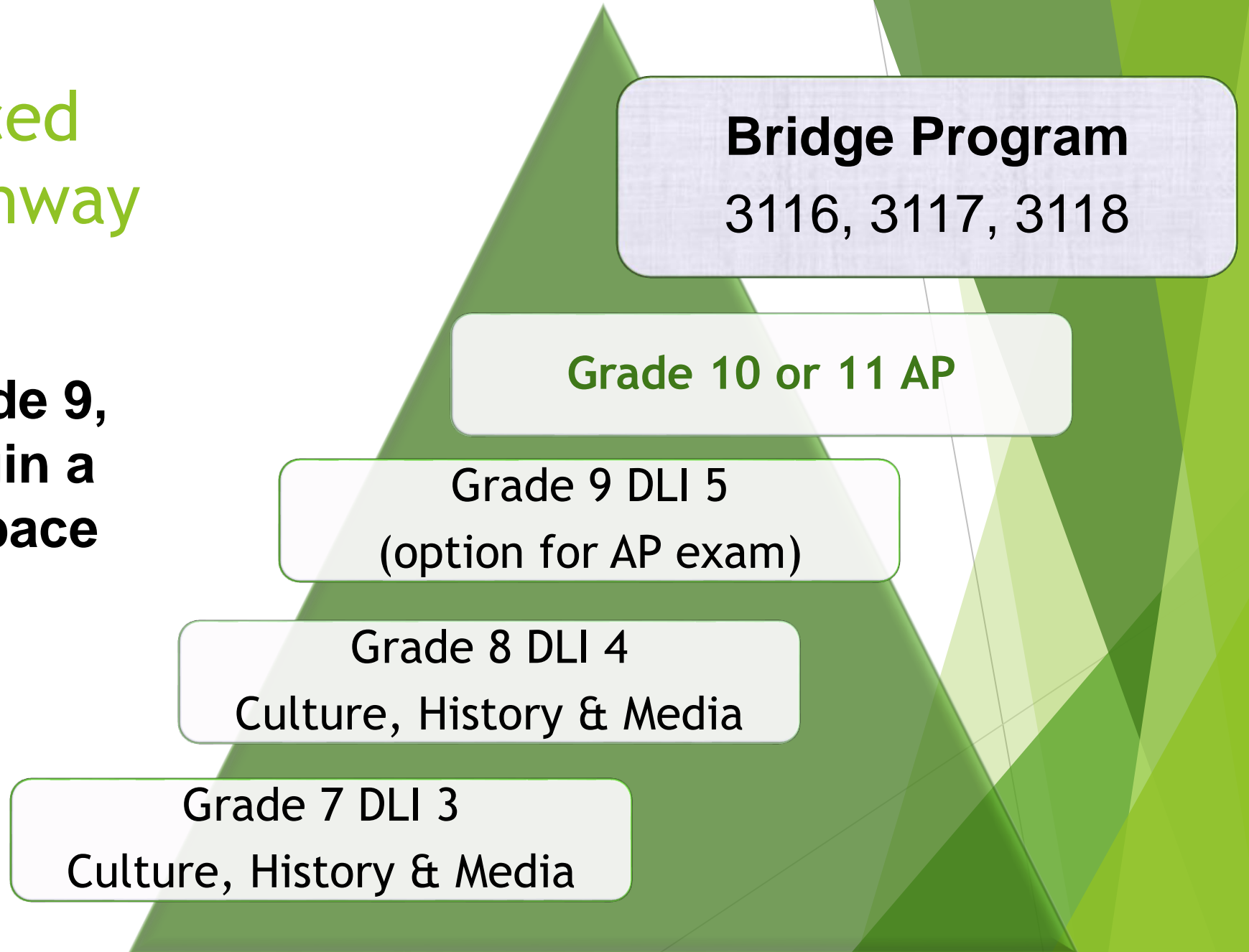
# Utah's Advanced Language Pathway

If a student attempts AP in 9<sup>th</sup> grade and scores a 3 or higher, they are accelerated to the Bridge Program course.



# Utah's Advanced Language Pathway

**Any student who passes AP in grade 9, 10, or 11 may begin a Bridge course, space permitting.**





# What are the current secondary courses?

- ▶ **7<sup>th</sup> Grade = Spanish/Chinese 3 DLI**
- ▶ **8<sup>th</sup> Grade = Spanish/Chinese 4 DLI**
- ▶ **9<sup>th</sup> Grade = Spanish/Chinese 5 DLI (AP prep course)**
- ▶ **7<sup>th</sup> -9<sup>th</sup> Grade - Culture History and Media (CHM)**
  - ▶ 4 Modules available
    - ▶ Module A is taught at ACYI, B is available at ACYI, B & C 8<sup>th</sup> grade and B,C & D can be taken in 9<sup>th</sup>

## 8<sup>th</sup> Grade = DLI 4

- ▶ This course continues the development of speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. Narratives and dialogues are used to teach structure and vocabulary. Culture and geography of the native country are taught through reading selections.
- ▶ For dual immersion students only.

## 9<sup>th</sup> Grade = DLI 5 (AP prep course)

- ▶ This course continues the development of communication by integrating speaking, listening, reading and writing around AP Themes and Tasks. Cultural comparison, authentic readings, persuasive essay practice and class discussions are used to teach structure and vocabulary. Students have the opportunity to take the AP exam at the end of the course.
- ▶ For dual immersion students only.

# What can the students achieve at the end of 12<sup>th</sup> grade?

- ▶ Example = University of Utah
  - ▶ AP = 6 Credits with a score of 3-4  
8 Credits with a score of 5
  - ▶ Available 3000 college credit in High School = 9 Credits
  - ▶ **TOTAL = Between 15-17 high level college credit**
- ▶ Note= University of Utah requires 15-18 credits with 6 credits required at the University of Utah to be eligible for a minor, so students may graduate from High School with only 2 classes left for a Spanish Minor.

# Is it *The Bridge* same as concurrent enrollment?

THE BRIDGE	CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Offers 3000 Level courses which are considered high level courses accepted for Minor/Major</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Usually offers 1000-2000 level courses that only can be used for pre-requisites.</li></ul>
